

Either way, it will be a fun week!




We had a busy January in the Studio!

We painted fireworks with watercolors and they exploded with added salt. We also learned about the artist, Piet Mondrian. We were influenced by his art and printed with square and rectangle sponges. Piet Mondrain liked to use primary colors, so we were able to review our primary colors. We also reviewed our seconday colors and divided them into cool and warm colors before we painted hearts.

We used a toliet paper tube bent into a heart shape to print cool hearts (blue, green, purple) or warm hearts (red, orange, yellow).

Another art element we learned about was LINES. We read the book, <u>Larry The Line</u> to learn about horizontal, vertical and diagonal lines. We then made snowflakes with strips of paper using the various directions. We are looking forward to the month of love and all the heart activites we have planned!
